Things we can all do together ...

Ascension Day - Ignite

We will be launching **Thy Kingdom Come** at our monthly Ignite prayer meeting on Ascension Day. We are running this as a Zoom meeting this month.

Join us for an **8.15pm** start **TOMORROW - Thursday 21 May**. It would be amazing if we could break the record for the number of people joining to pray at 'Ignite'!

The Zoom call will be open from 8.05pm, so please do join in plenty of time so we can start promptly at 8.15pm.

The details you need to be able to join are available on the parish newsletter (sent Wednesday 20th May) or from your Congregational leader.

If you are unable to use the Zoom application you can still join in by dialling in from your phone using any of the numbers listed in the parish newsletter (also sent Wednesday 20th May)

24-7 prayer

After the ascension the disciples "joined together constantly in prayer"

(Acts 1:14) as they waited for the day of Pentecost. We cannot meet together physically to pray at the moment, but we want to have a wave of continuous prayer from Ascension Day to Pentecost Sunday.

We are running a 24-7 virtual prayer room. You can sign up in hourly slots to commit to pray during that hour. You can sign up with a group of friends, or with your Life Group, for that hour, or sign up as individuals. We will be praying **from 10:00pm on 21 May through to 9:00am on 31 May.**

The Warfield Upper Room

For the last 24 hours **from 9:00am on Saturday 30 May until 9:00am on Sunday 31 May**, as part of our 24-7 prayer we will have a continuous Zoom prayer meeting running which you can participate in at any point. Just turn up and pray with whoever is online at the time. The Zoom details will be the same as for the evening meetings throughout the ten days (see parish Newsletter sent Wednesday 20th May or contact your congregational leader).

Daily Prayer Meetings

Morning Prayer will continue on Facebook live, Monday **to Saturday, at 9:00am**. And there will also be an **evening prayer meeting**, via Zoom at 8pm **every day from Friday 22 May to Saturday 30 May**. We know that some of our congregations already had prayer meetings planned for this period and we are planning that they will lead us all in these evening prayer meetings. The Zoom details for this meeting are the same as for the **Ignite** prayer meeting above (see Newsletter as mentioned earlier).

Things we can do individually or as a family ...

In addition to joining in the daily prayer meetings [above] there are a

number of resources to help guide you as you pray each day:

As individuals:

Pray for 5 - Ask God to bring to mind 5 people that you want to come to know and follow Jesus. Commit to pray for them each day.

The Church of England Daily prayer App gives the service liturgy for morning, midday, evening and night daily prayer. Download from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#). Note this is a different app to the TKC one above.

A podcast featuring all eight hours of the Daily Prayer for Thy Kingdom Come audio is also available via iTunes, Spotify and other podcast providers.

Smart speaker – from Thursday 21 May (Ascension Day), you can also get Alexa and Google Home to 'Ask the Church of England for today's Thy Kingdom Come' to hear a short service of Prayer During the Day (before 7pm) and Night Prayer (after 7pm) throughout the 11 days.

As a family:

Pray for 5 - Pray together each day for 5 people that you want to come to know and follow Jesus.

The Digital Family Prayer Adventure map. A map you can download and print off, with an augmented reality app that is used in collaboration with the map. The app features daily games and videos which will all be delivered through innovative augmented reality
