This year we are proud to welcome back Major General Tim Cross CBE (retired). Tim is a former Director General of the UK Defence Supply Chain. He served in the first Gulf War in 1990/91 and in Iraq in 2003, as well as three times in the Balkans, including Kosovo, and Northern Ireland. He was the General Officer Commanding Theatre Troops and latterly the Army adviser to the

House of Commons Defence Select Committee.

A Local Lay Minister in the Church of England and the Chairman of the Board of Christian think tank, *Theos*, Tim works with a number of charity and humanitarian organisations. Amongst a broad portfolio he is also a Facilitator at the Leadership Trust; sits on the Ethics board of a major UK technology

company; is an Honorary Professor at three UK Universities and the President of the Institute of Civil Protection and Emergency Management.
