 the children to school (the current one is old, and too small).
- Pray for the 3 upcoming weddings in the Aanandit Church.
- And please pray for the country of Nepal. There continue to be groups with significant traction who aim to persecute Christians. Furthermore, there is expected to be heavy rain in the coming monsoon season, which will cause further unrest in the country. Please pray for God's protection over the Aanandit centre.
