Mission Partner Focus

Our prayers this week are for the St Peter's Lifeline charity (SPL), who are helping the people of Kajuki, Kenya.

Please pray for them on the points below. You can find more detail in their <u>First Friday</u> Prayers.

- Pray for the sponsored education scheme SPL are currently sponsoring 122 children and young people! However, this is greater than the number of sponsors they have, so please pray that more funding will become available.
- Furthermore, the school meals scheme is starting again now that Summer holidays are over. This provides lunchtime meals every day for over 1800 primary school children, which encourages children to attend school.
- And please pray for further funding of all SPL projects. SPL have entered a severe funding shortage, but are continuing to try and support all of their projects where possible. Please pray for continued provisions so they can keep supporting the people of Kajuki.
