MISSION PARTNERS: HANDS ON HOUSES



The focus of our Mission Partner prayers this week is Hands on Houses, founded by Don and Margie Cook. They are a small non-profit organisation with global construction experience who build houses for people who need them most. Over the years they have built nearly 500 houses across 7 countries.

Please pray for them on the points below.

- Pray for the 2025 Christmas challenge! Each year, Hands on Houses challenge themselves to fund a number of houses in the month of December. Their goal is to fund 25 houses this Christmas (which will be built in 2026). Each house costs about £4500.
- Pray for Don and Margie's travels, which they call "fun(d) raising". They speak at conferences, churches, and to small family groups over coffee. In recent weeks they've been touring Western America – Hawaii, California, Arizona and are now in Colorado.
- And give thanks for the longevity of this charity and the people involved. Hands on Houses are projected to build their 500th house by the end of 2025!
