MISSION PARTNERS: THE DOMINGOS



Our prayers this week are for Ron and Joanna Domingo. They are based in Manila in the Philippines and have been there since 2007. They have established a worshipping church community around the area of the Tondo Rubbish Dump. They work with Kalayaan Community Ministries (KCM).

Please pray for them on the points below:

- Give thanks for the Christmas celebrations, which included on 24th December a “volunteer appreciation night” for all those who help with KCM. This included a night of worship and fellowship, as well as presentations, games and food. Many of the volunteers lost their homes in the fires in September, but are still faithful to God and passionate about serving the church and community. They have lost so much but are rebuilding their lives little by little.
- Give thanks for the 4-day youth camp which took place at the start of January. Over 50 young people attended the camp, and many of them also lost their homes in the fire. Some also struggled with resisting the use of cigarettes and drugs. However, God was at work, as baptisms took place, and the camp provided a joyous opportunity that some of the youth may not receive otherwise.
- And pray for what is come for the Tondo area in 2026. The rebuilding from the fires is progressing, but is a slow process. But the church and community remain hopeful, and there are members embarking on short missionary trips to other areas too. The rebuilding has also allowed for projects like the KCM “safe house” to be redesigned and have better facilities.
