# MISSION PARTNERS: HANDS ON HOUSES



The focus of our Mission Partner prayers this week is *Hands on Houses*, founded by Don and Margie Cook. They are a small non-profit organisation with global construction experience who build houses for people who need them most. Over the years they have built over 500 houses across 7 countries.

- Pray for the 100-house target in 2026. In the last 2 years ('24 and '25), *Hands on Houses* have aimed to build 100 houses in a year – but have fallen short on both financial and practical resources (lack of building partners). For this year, they have enough building partners to meet the target...will 2026 be the best year yet for *Hands on Houses*?
- However, more funding will be needed to meet the target. Each house costs only a few thousand pounds. There are important meetings coming up with possible donors – one of them today! (Friday). And there are always ongoing conversations with more building partners; *Hands on Houses* need wisdom to know which are the right partners to build with.
- And please pray for the health of Don and Margie. They are not young, and lately, Don's back has been giving him trouble. Despite all this though, Don and Margie continue to work with extraordinary energy and spirit!
