National Emergency Briefing

The BFCCA will be hosting Bracknell's first screening of the National Emergency Briefing (NEB) on Thursday 19th June, at 6pm in the Bracknell Town Library.

The NEB was held on 27th November 2025, when ten of the UK's leading experts briefed an invited audience of more than 1,200 politicians and leaders from business, culture, faith, sport and the media in Westminster.

The briefing set out the implications of climate and nature breakdown for health, food systems, national security and the economy, and did so on the public record. Its purpose was to demonstrate what a clear, evidence-led national emergency briefing could look like and why it is needed.

MISSION PARTNERS: THE ADHIKARIS



Our prayers this week are for the Adhikari family in Nepal. We have supported Milan and Shusma, and the Aanandit Church and Charity, since 2002. They currently have 23 church plants in Nepal, and have a vision to grow to 40 by the year 2033!

Please pray for them on the points below:

- Give thanks for the evangelism that has taken place this year. An Easter rally in Kathmandu saw over 35,000 Nepali Christians meet together. In the Aanandit Church, two new congregations have been planted and 17 people baptised since the start of 2026.
- Pray for the evangelism and training courses which have happened/are happening recently. Discipleship and bible study courses are taking place weekly for both women and young people. Milan led a prayer travel group which spent two days travelling North and South across Nepal. Another mission group travelled to Western Nepal, distributing 280 Bibles and sowing the seeds of a new church congregation.
- And please pray for the Adhikari family's upcoming trip to the UK, which includes joining the Ichthus Revive Conference in early August. Please pray for eldest daughter Amishu who has been accepted into university in the UK!
