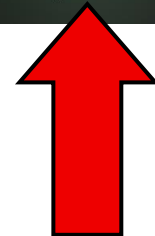
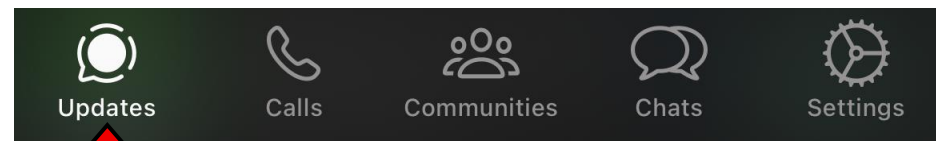

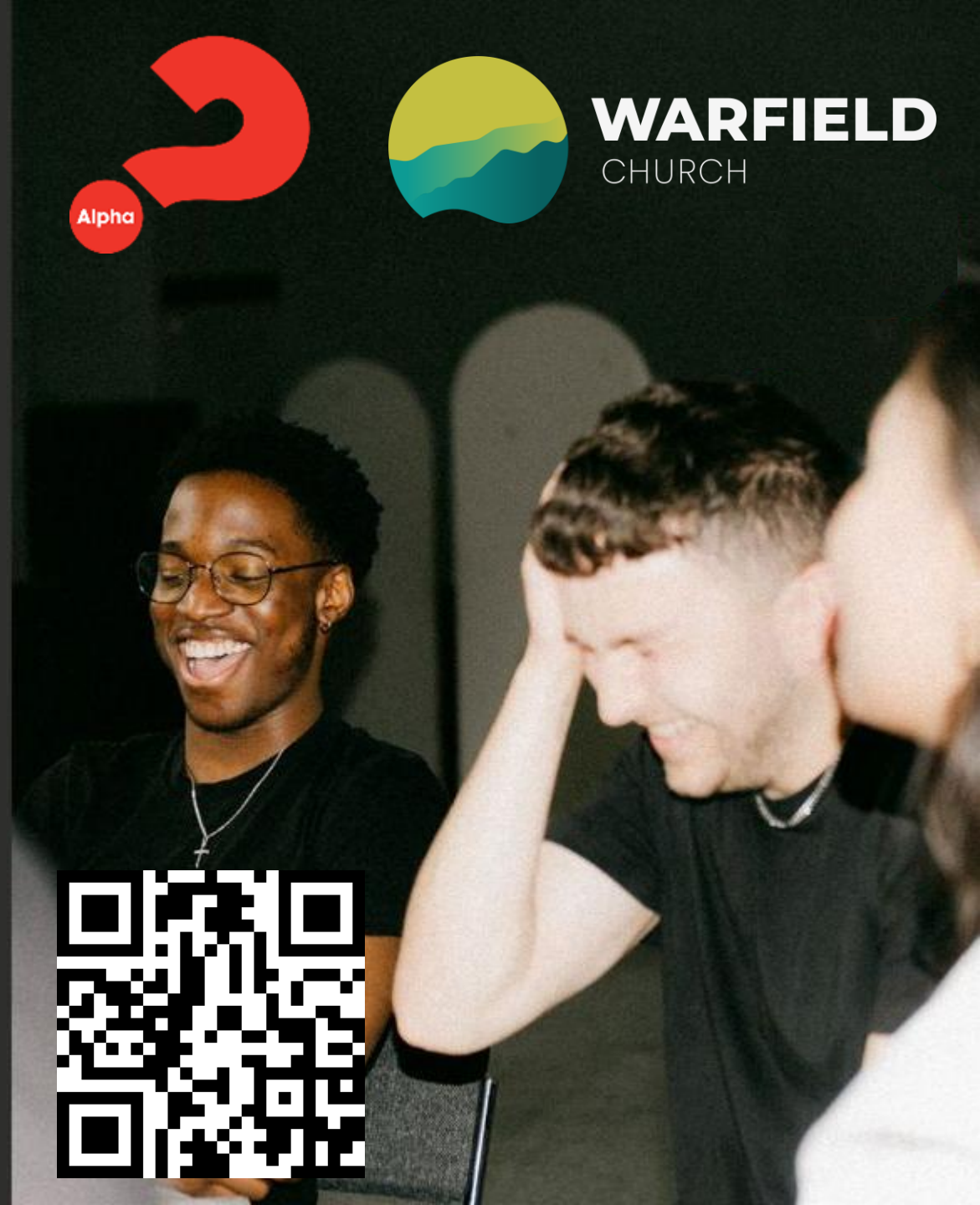

Our animals bring us so much joy and teach us so much about love.

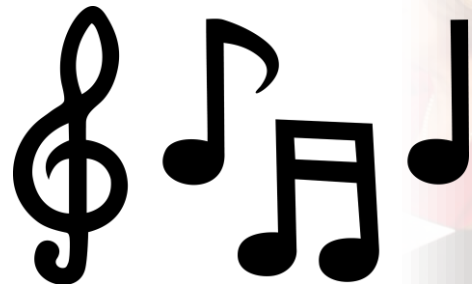
Bring your pet along to our special service to give thanks and pray God's blessing on them. The service will last for about 45 minutes – all animals welcome as long as you can keep them under control!

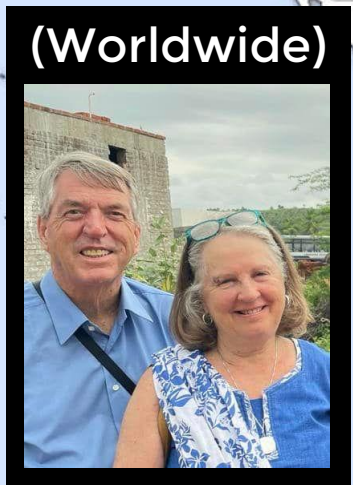
