Prayer points for month of June:

June 2 Tuesday : Please pray for the Aanandit Mission Team who have just returned from a ministry trip to western Nepal. We thank God that they distributed over **280 Bibles**, shared more than **2,000 Gospel tracts**, and encouraged Aanandit churches along their journey.

Pray that the seeds of God's Word sown during this trip will bear much fruit and lead many to Christ.
